



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary bearing date the eighth day of March Anno Domini 1737 Surveyed to John Carr of the County of Lancaster four hundred acres of Land with the farther addition of sixty acres in the Townships of Donegal & Derry in the County of Lancaster afd. Beginning at a post a corner of Christopher Vanleers Land thence by the same Land North 86 1/2 degra. west 195 perches to a white oak thence West by the Land of David McNear 88 perches to a white oak a corner of George Davisons Land thence by the Land of ye sd. George Davison South 16 Degr. West 84 perches to a Black Oak thence South 25 Degr East by the Land of Saml. Smith 210 perches to a white oak thence East 140 perches to a post thence North East by East 80 perches to a hickory thence North East by North 177 perches to a white oak thence North West 45 perches to Conewago Creek thence North ^{57 degra} West ~~45~~ ⁶⁷ perches to the place of Beginning Containing in the whole four hundred & sixty acres and the usual allowance of Six pcent for Roads &c. Surveyd ye 1st of June 1739
