



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the twenty Eighth day of August 1734 Surveyed unto Garret Clements a tract of Land Situate in the Township of Salford in the County of Philada. Beginning at a post a corner of Christian Allowback's land thence by the same South west one hundred and twenty four perches to a post thence by land of Andrew Ledrah North West forty perches to post thence by land of sd. Garret Clements North East one hundred and Twenty four perches to a post thence by land of ~~Henry Rudt~~ <sup>Henry Rudt</sup> ~~David Johnson~~ South East forty perches to the place of Beginning containing Twenty Nine acres with the usual allowance of Six pcent.
