D. 1830 by John Andrews then Deputy Surveyor for Warren County and afterwards conveyed from Betsy Culbertson to Charles Mc Nair and is now claimed by Fidelio W. Brigham by virtue of a conveyance from Charles Mc Nair to the said Fidelio W. Brigham and no part of the above described Forty Seven Acres and thirty four perches is claimed by any person except the said Fidelio W. Brigham to the best of my knowledge and belief.
