



In Pursuance of a warrant Dated 22<sup>nd</sup> March 1750 Granted to George Weidner (by the name of George (oblique) surveyed on the 24<sup>th</sup> April 1786 for the use of a Church & School House, the above described Tract of Land, Situate in Brunswick Township in the County of Berks, Containing One Hundred & ten Acres & 99 Perches and allowance of 6 Cent for roads &c. - called "Canterbury" -
