



Draught of a Tract of Land Situate five Miles from Clearfield Creek on a Branch leading to said Creek about two miles above the Mouth of said Creek called the Spruce Bottom crossing the Path leading from Bald Eagle to Chincleanouch Old Town in the County of Bedford Containing four hundred and five Acres & one hundred and thirty two perches & the usual Allowance of six Per Cent. for Roads &c Surveyed June 29th 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Isaac Wilson Dated 1st July 1784 —
