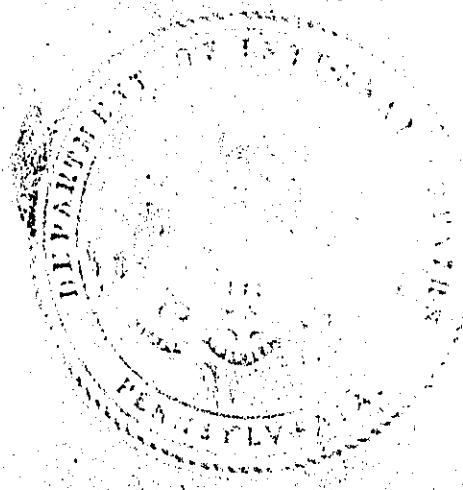
To B. There is two actual resident settlements on the above survey - one of which is about 27 years old

Note this survey is made according to old marks and lines which I found on the premises made by Stephen and John Gaper upward of 25 years ago. according to courses and distances of one Charles Shoemaker's survey there is a little interference as will appear by the dotted lines. Shoemaker's land is Warr. to Joseph Gynan, survey, dated = Sept. 1793

Note further William Hoople desired me to note at the bottom of survey that he had a claim to some part of the above survey
