

The Above is a draught of a tract of Land situate on Waters of Waddy Creek Call'd 'Roach' Containing three hundred & ninety nine Acres and sixty two perches surveyed June the 3^d 1785 in pursuance of the hereto Under Certificates Granted to John Swan

By the Commissioner appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia & Ohio do hereby certify that John Swan is entitled to four hundred acres of ^{land} in the County of Monongalia on Waddy Creek to be bounded with in the lines marked out by him to include his settlement made in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy.

Given under our hands at Rock Stone old fort this seventeenth day of November 1789 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth

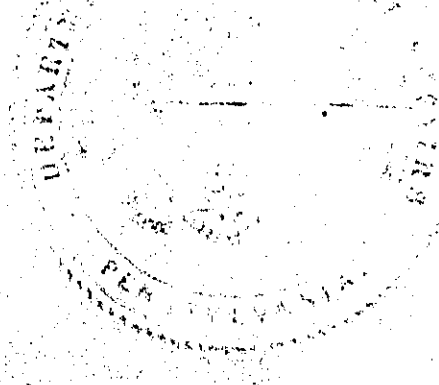
