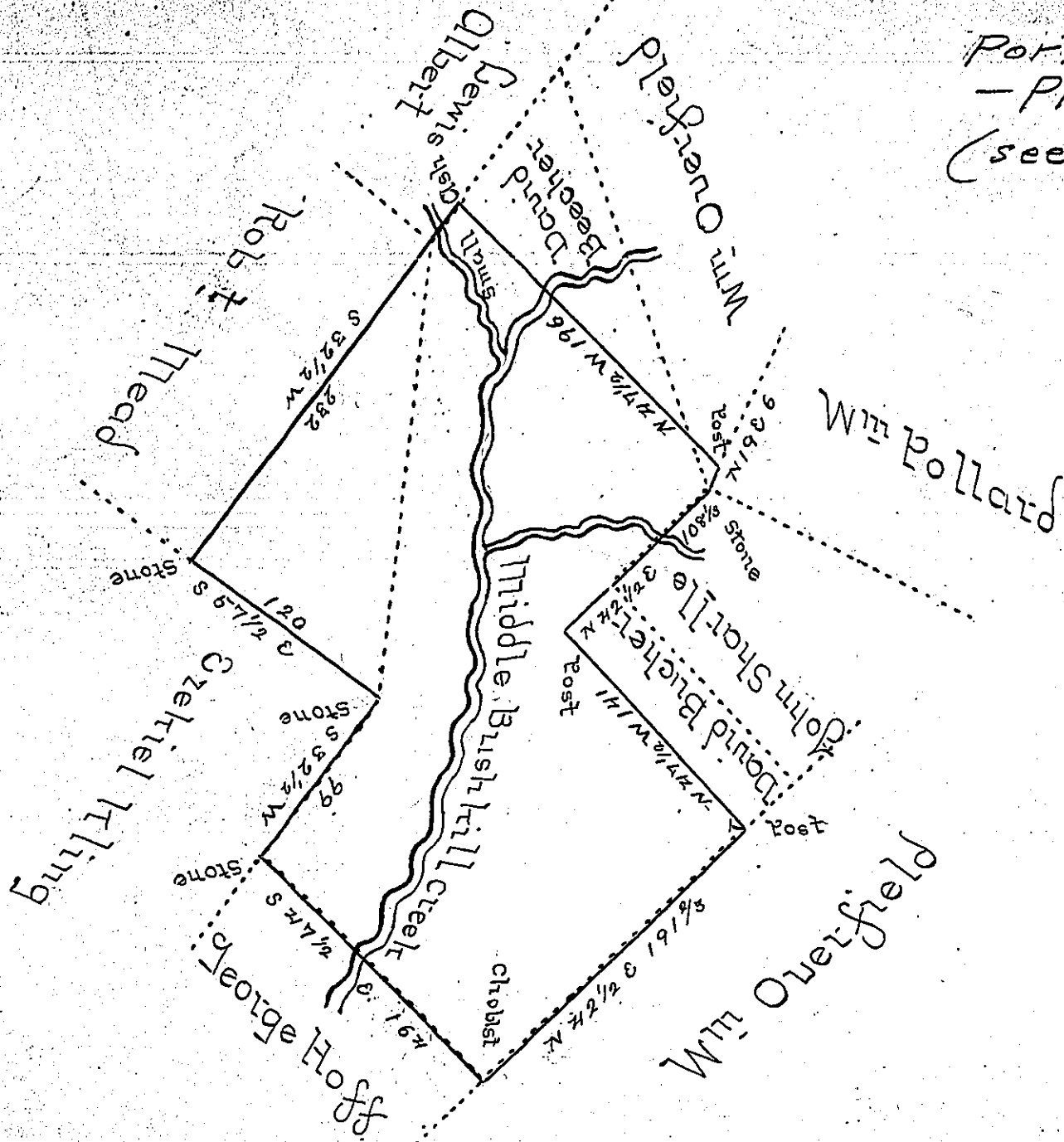

By Virtue of a Warrant dated January 29th 1793 and Order of Survey. Received August 1st 1843. Surveyed the 1st of Jan^y 1846. to Abraham Dehoff the above described Tract of Land for Jacob Shoemaker, Situate in Lehman Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County Adjoining Land Granted to George Hoff Containing four hundred five Acres Ninety six perches and Allowance of six pct for Roads.
