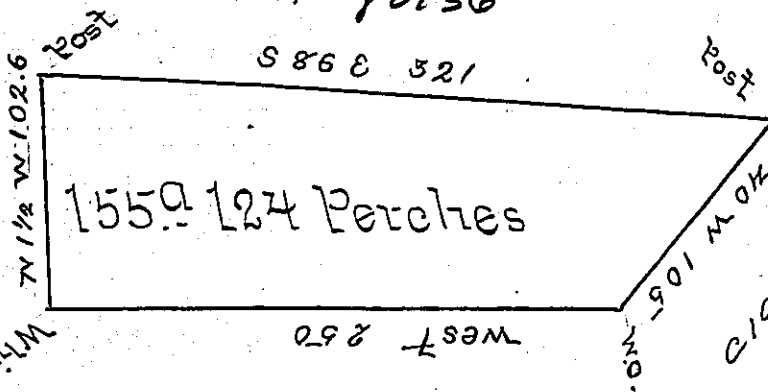

By Virtue of a Warrant granted to Thomas Swearenger dated on the 13th day of February 1797 the above described tract of Land containing one hundred fifty five Acres & one hundred and twenty four perches together with six per Cent Allowance for Roads Situate on the Waters of Cross Creek in Cross Creek Township Washington County was Surveyed on the 10th day of September 1797 by Thomas Stokely Esquire late Deputy Surveyor and now Examined and Certified to be correct this 3^d day of February 1804.
