



The Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Cumru Township Lancaster County Surveyed for Francis Creek the 19th of February A.D. 1744 by y^e order hereunto Annexed.

Francis Creek has long Requested me to make an addition to his Plantation Near Cockosing which when he first spoke to me might well have been Done, and may yet a far as I know without Injury to any and now that I Can't Conveniently do it my self I Desire you when you are thereabouts to Survey what shall appear to you Reasonable for an addition to the Survey I made for him and Give me a Draught of what you Survey &c. April 14th 1742 W^m Parsons
