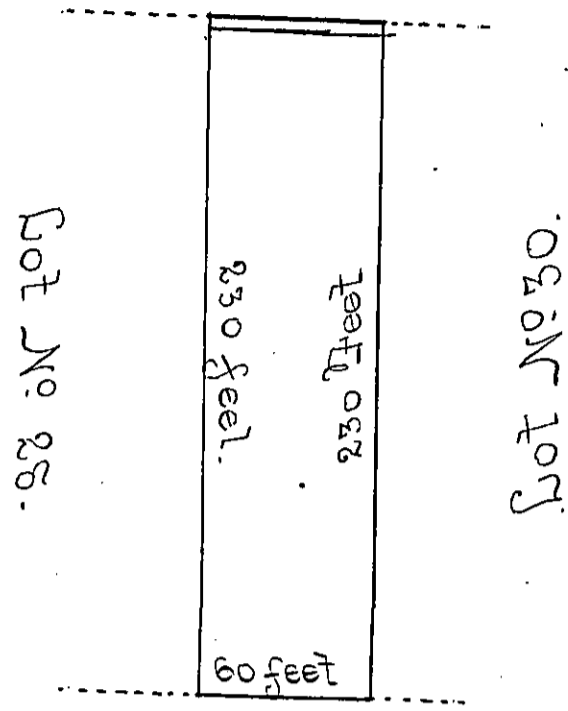


Twenty feet Alley

On pursuance of a verbal order from the Secretary there was surveyed for Isaac Levant a certain lot of land situate in the Town of Reading in the County of Philadelphia containing in Breadth East and West Sixty Feet and in Length two hundred and thirty Feet Bounded southward by Penn Street Eastward by Lot No 30. Northward by a twenty Feet Alley and Westward by Lot No 28. Being marked in a Plan of the said Town No 29 surveyed by me
