



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 1793 granted to Conrad Shindle and Order of Survey Received Jan. 7. 1843. Surveyed June 3<sup>d</sup>. 1843 the above described Tract of Land situate on the Waters of Little Bushkill and on the old Road leading from the Mouth of Bushkill to Shehola House about four Miles from Bushkill Bridge in Lehman Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County Containing four hundred and thirty four Acres and One hundred and fourteen perches and Allowance of six P<sup>t</sup> C<sup>t</sup> for Roads &c.
