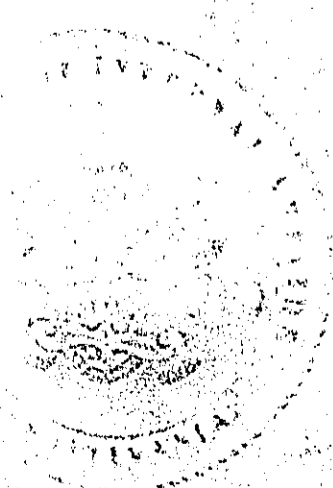

Michael Reed US Bedford County Description 400 acres adjoining lands this day granted to John Bell in the County of Huntingdon & ^{dated} the 5th March 1794 of which said Warrant a copy was directed to James M^cShahan Esq^r & myself for execution M^cShahan executed the survey and as the land was situated in Bedford County at the request of the present owner Zachariah Brown sent the same to me to make the return the Copy of the Warrant is in my Office these are all the facts I know of the above Case -
