



Situate on both sides of a branch of Dunbars Run about a mile and a half from Measons Mill in <sup>Fayette County</sup> Dunbar Township, (formerly supposed to be in Wharton before this line was established) and surveyed in September 1795 By Morris Morris for Alex<sup>r</sup> Mc Clean D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February 1793 Now finished from the notes & calculation of S<sup>r</sup> Morris
