



A Draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed by Virtue of a Warrant to Wm Gray dated the 18th November 1788 and ~~for~~ was said to be surveyed June 20th 1790. And was with the draught as above put into my hand for confirmation. I think in April last past and is found to contain as above one hundred and five acres and 7/8 of an acre of Land and Allowance is situated adjoining Jephthah Mortons Claim and lands of Andrew Edge and others in Buffalo township North^{bd} County Dated this first day of November 1804.
