

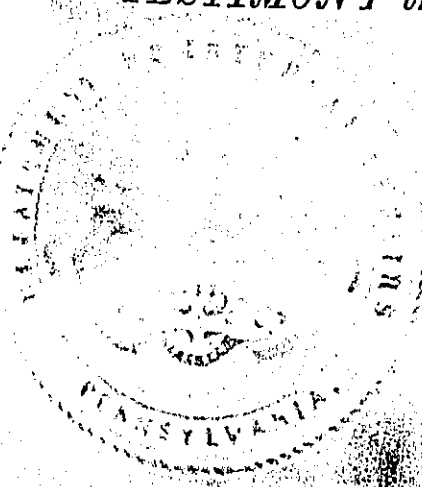
The Draught of a tract of Land situated in Bald Eagle Valley, Patton Township Centre County, Containing one hundred and ninety two acres thirty two perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 31st day of October 1811, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Brown dated the 14th October 1811, including his improvement made in April 1795 - At the time of making the survey Thomas Brown & family lived on the premises, on which there is a Dwelling House & Barn, an Orchard of apple & peach Trees, with about forty acres of Clear land and other improvements
