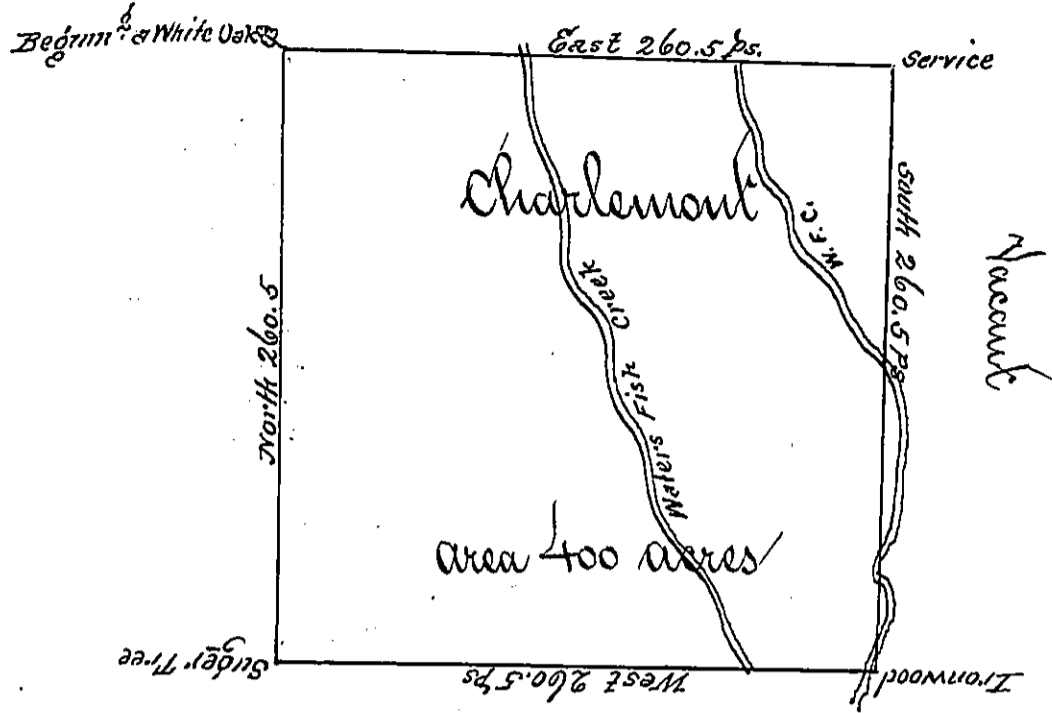


James Douglass

In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Dougless Dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1784 situated on the Waters of Fish Creek adjoining Lands of James Dougless in Washington County Called Charlemont Containing four hundred Acres with the usual Allowance of six per Cent for Decads
