



The Above is a Draught of a Survey made the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1785 in pursuance of warrant granted to Patrick Deher Dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of Oct<sup>r</sup> 1784 situate on the waters of Fish Creek in Washington County Called Eagles Nest Containing four hundred Acres with usual Allowance of 6 p<sup>ct</sup> Cent for Roads
