



By virtue of an Application dated the 11<sup>th</sup> June 1769 No. 4066 surveyed the 31 March 1792 to Valentine and Daniel Showalter the above described tract of land situate in Allen Township Northampton County containing forty six acres 100 perches & the allowance of six per cent for To B. James Deemphill told me there was no Application for Showalter he obtained a Warrant the 10 August 1791 had a survey made & returned the 6 June 1796 for the above land The land was formerly surveyed by James Scull I never see the application until this 9 March 1797.
