



Situate in Shanokin Township of Northumberland County, on the head waters of Coal run, near Shanokin Creek on the west side of it, near the old Beading Road to Sunbury and northward from the Hocust Mountain and from the lands of Brobst & Biddle & Co. Containing three hundred sixty acres and eighty four perches to the acre of six per cent. Surveyed for Hugh Bellas, on the 22nd day of February 1830 by virtue of his warrant dated the 6th day of January 1830.
