dwelling house on the above, the house is situated on the Northern boundary line of the  
survey between the small run and the road, occupied by Ezra Swope, who is a tenant  
of John Flomigan of Philadelphia, said Flomigan claims the part of the above  
survey lying East of the Resurvey line (marked in the above with red ink) by virtue of a  
purchase at Sheriff's sale.
