



The above is a draught of a survey made the 15 day of September 1813, in pursuance of a Warrant granted Andrew Sweringer dated the 26 day of March 1788, containing 98 1/2 acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate on the waters of Ruffs Creek a branch of the South fork of Tenmile Creek in Morgan Township Greene County
