


Nathan Prior's Heirs



The above is a draught of a Survey made the 8 day of May 1810. In pursuance of a warrant granted Charity Jones the 27 day of February 1810 Containing 12 acres & 28 perches of Land, ^{with allowance of six per cent} situate in Jefferson Township on the waters of Ten Mile Creek. Called Aberdeen.
