



Survey'd for David Candler on the 15th day of June 1807. He above described a Tract containing two hundred and ten Acres and seventy two perches and the usual Allowance of six for land in the forks of Brush Creek and Black Lick about four or five miles west from William Brackens Mill in Fairfield now Wheatfield Township, by warrant of the 7th day of February 1774.

N.B. That part of the above Tract represented by the dotted lines and letters A. & B. was survey'd to Robert Weir on the 4th Octob^r 1792, by Warrant of the 14th September, 1792.
