Timothy Green, according to the agreement of the Officers of Col. Francis's Corps in their division of a tract of Eight Thousand acres of land granted to, and surveyed for them in Buffalo Valley aforesaid on the 10th, 2^d and 3^d days of March Anno Dom. 1769, In pursuance of Order No. 1.
