



Situate in Springfield Township Huntingdon County containing four hundred forty five acres 50 perches & allowance Originally Surveyed in 1767 By Richard Tea, D.S. of the district at that time In pursuance of an Order of Survey No. 1812. dated the 4th. of Novr. 1766 granted to Lawrence Peterson & Resurveyed by John Cannan, D.S. the 2nd. of Novr. 1795 Througling out a part of the Land which Richard Tea, had inclosed (along the Black Log Mountain) but without Legal Authority - Resurveyed the 19th. day of Decr. 1832 agreeable to the original lines (made by Richard Tea) D.S. in 1767 - In pursuance of an order of resurvey Granted by the Board of property, on application of Thomas Duncan Esq. by Thomas Smith Esq. dated the 4th. of August 1801
