



A draught of a tract of land situate on Little Tuscarora Creek in the Township of Wyalusing Bradford County containing four Hundred and thirty three acres and one hundred and fifty three perches and allowance of six percent for roads said to have been surveyed in September 1793 to George Pimm which (from corners to be found) appears to have been done. Resurvey - the 10th day of December 1813 In pursuance of a warrant dated the 25 day of February 1793 to the same by Jonathan Stevens L.S.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixth day of August 1901
