In pursuance of an Entry made in the Office of Br. Johnston Surveyor of Yohogania County later in the State of Virginia dated March 22nd. 1780 was Survey'd for Thomas Spencer the above described Tract of Land containing Two Hundred & Forty two acres & thirty six perches with an allowance proportioned to six pcent. Including his Settlement made thereon in the year 1773 nigh Alleganey river adjoining Land Dr. Smith & others in Pitt Township Westmoreland County Survey'd Sept. 9th. 1785 p.
