



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 3d July
1784 Surveyed the 14 September 1784 to Giles Ramsey the
above described tract of Land situate at the head of a small
branch of Lachawapen River called Tinker Wig brook &
nearly adjoining the South Westerly side of a Pond being
one of the branches of Mack hope Creek in Northampton
County Containing Three hundred and eighty six acres
one hundred and fifty perches and the allowance of
six plant Yds.
