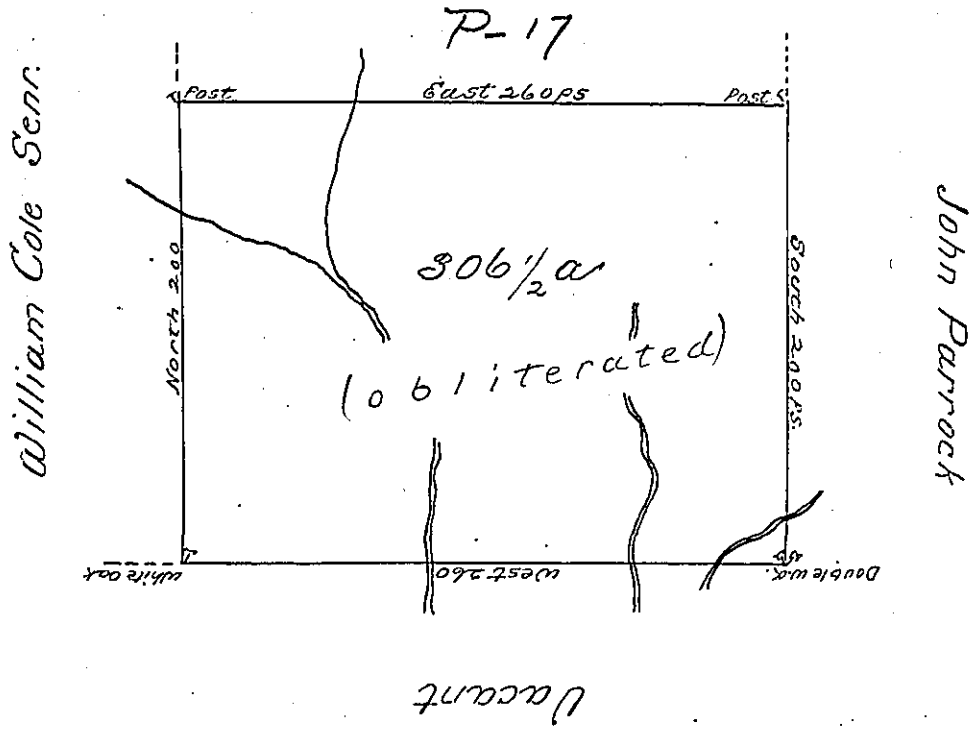


Wm. Hopkins Junr.
