



Situate on the North side of Birds road in Manallin Township Fayette County and was Surveyed the 29th day of February 1785 In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 26th day of January 1785 - was returned into the Surveyor General's office - located by Edward Todd which caveat is removed & the controversy settled - it also materially interfered with a Survey made for Thomas McShoy - located by the Agent of Briscoe, but destroyed by McShoy (he being the bearer of the return) in closing the caveat) patent was obtained by McShoy - set aside in the Supreme Court by reason of the fraud, and Judgment was obtained in favour of Briscoe the heirs ^{have} of Todd their right - And upon resurveying the same I have discovered an error in the former Survey which has not affected the quantity much I have herein rectified the error and explained the former blunder - there is now no impediment in the way of patenting to the assignee of Briscoe's heirs, that I know of
