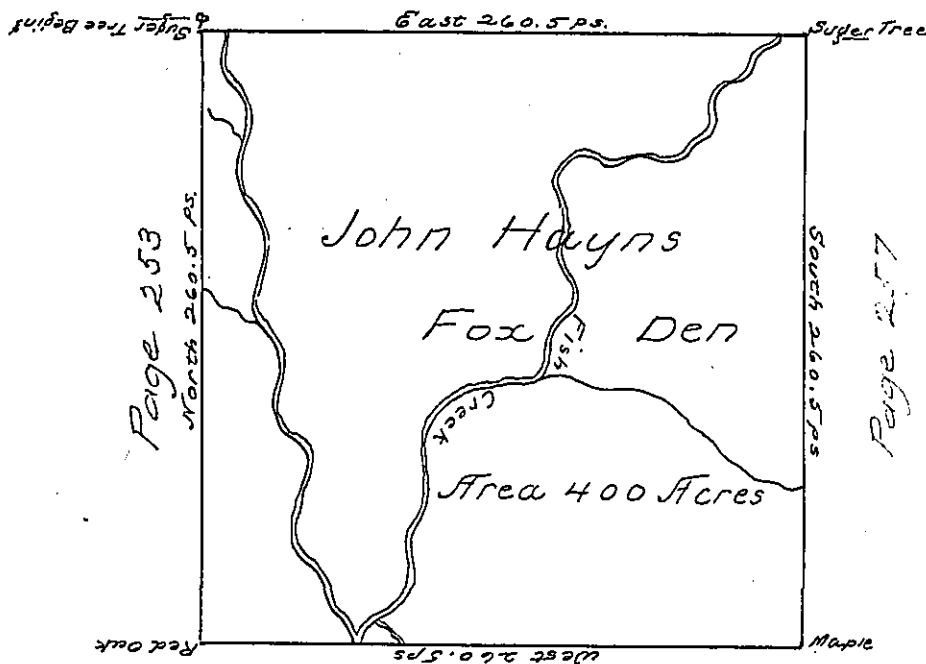

Situate on a Branch of fish Creek called Fox Den - in Washington County Containing four hundred acres with usual allowances of 6 ps. Cent for Roads.
