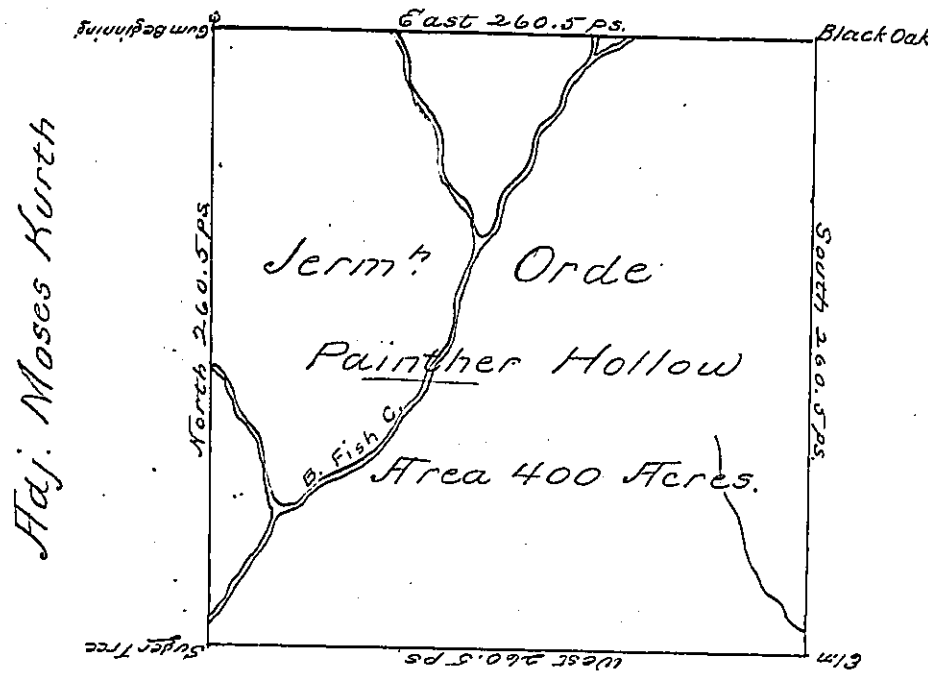


Adj Nathan Still
