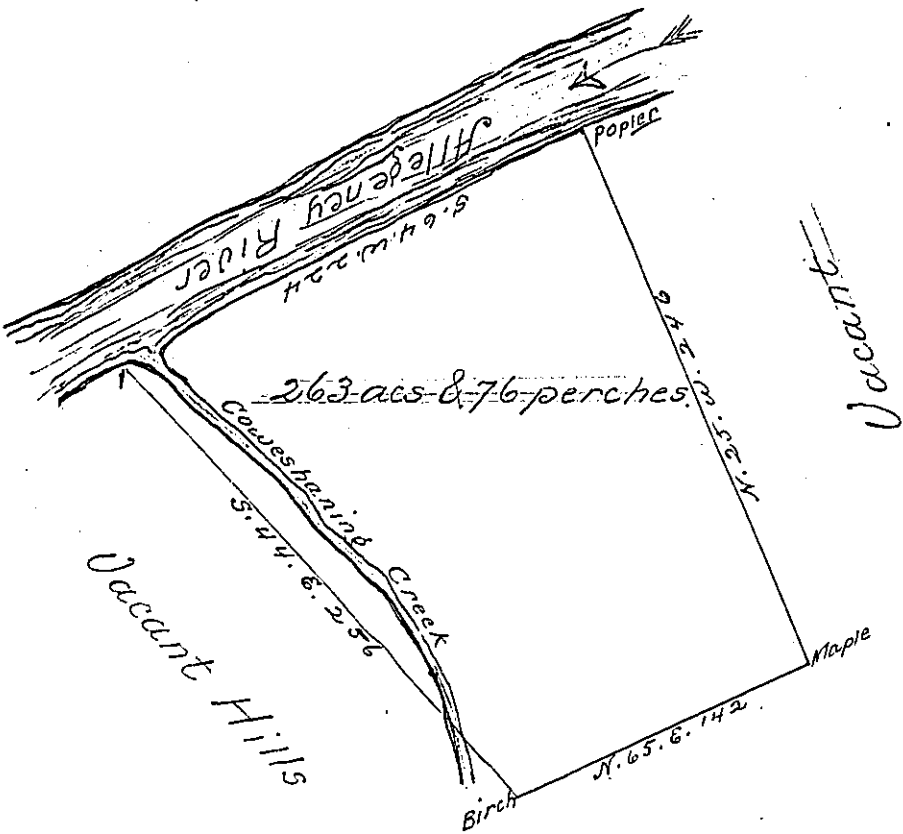


Warrant No. 747  
for 200 acres.



Surveyed the 15th day of October 1786 the above described Tract of land for Robert Sample containing two hundred and sixty three acres and seventy six perches with the usual allowance of Six poles. Situated and lying on the East Side of Allegheny River and including the mouth of Coweshaning creek in pursuance of a warrant granted him the 7th day of Aprile 1786 from the land office for lands in late purchase Northumberland County
