



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the fourteenth day of March 1733. Surveyed unto John Conrad Reed a tract of Land situate near Coie brook Dale in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a white oak a Corner of Anthony Morris's Land thence by the same South West one hundred and ninety three perches to a Hickory thence by Vacant Land North West one hundred and thirty two perches to a Corner stone thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and ninety three perches to a Chestnut Oak, thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and thirty two perches to the place of Beginning. Containing one hundred and fifty acres with the usual allowance of six ft. Cord. Surveyed Septem^r 3. 1734.
