



By Virtue of a Warrant from y^e Propr^s ^{dated the 29th day of Jan^{ry} 1734} surveyed on y^e eighteenth Day of March 1734 to Hans Bower a Tract of Land Situate on a branch of Perkiome near Newcowifshoppin in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a corner post of John Sinsman land thence by land of Humphrey Hill South forty Degrees West one Hundred and fifty nine perches to a post thence by Vacant land North forty Degrees East one hundred and sixty Perches to a stone put for a Corner. Thence by Vacant land North forty Degrees East one hundred and fifty nine perches to a hickry a corner of y^e afores^d John Sinsman's land thence by the same South fifty Degrees East one hundred and sixty perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty Acres with usual Allowance
