



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1720 <sup>for one hundred acres</sup> Surveyed to Peter Bartolet a tract of land situate in Oley in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup> Beginning at a post in a line of Ulrick Haggaman's land thence by the same & Vacant land South East one hundred & sixty perches to a post thence by Vacant land North East one hundred & fifty nine perches to a large Hickery thence by Vacant land North West one hundred & sixty perches to a post thence by Vacant land South West one hundred & fifty nine perches to y<sup>e</sup> place of Beginning Containing one hundred & fifty acres with y<sup>e</sup> usual Allowance of six p Cent

Surveyed March 30<sup>th</sup> 1720
