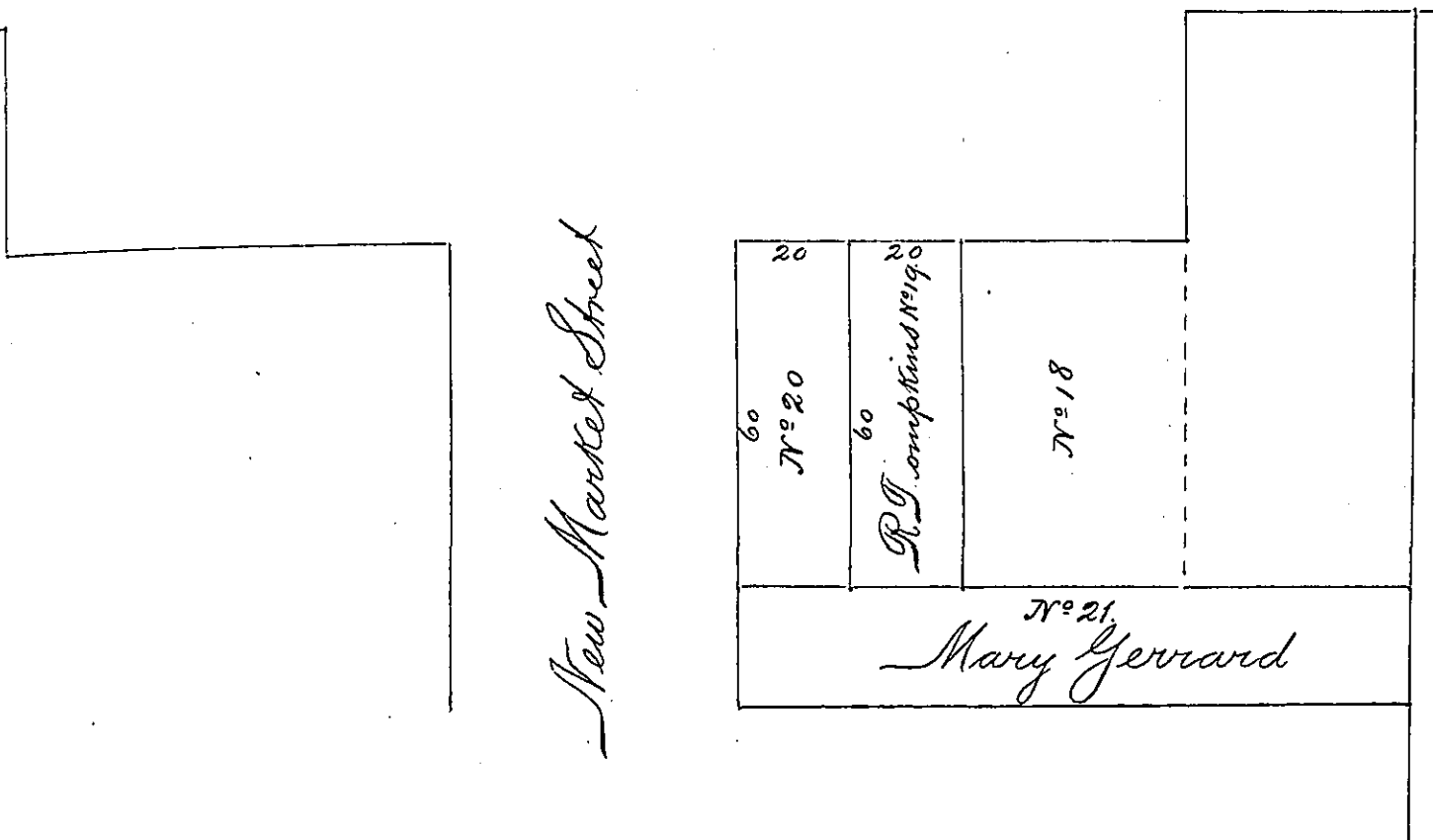


## Callowhill Market place and Street



In pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July 1772, <sup>granted to Robert J. Tompkins</sup> for a Lot of Ground to the Northward of the City and without the Limits thereof on the Callowhill Street or Fronting the New Market place there, I did on the day following Survey and lay out <sup>the said</sup> for Robert J. Tompkins the Lot above described being No. 19 in the plan of the Hougle Proprietaries Grounds there containing in Breadth on the New Market place twenty feet and in Length sixty feet Bounded Northward by the New Market place aforesaid Eastward by Lot No. 18 Southward by Mary Gervards Lot No. 21. and Westward by Lot No. 20.
