



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries Bearing Date the 5th Day of February Anno Dom: 1739 Surveyed to John Galbreith a tract of Land Situate on Little Chickasawgo^{Creek} in Donegal Township in Lancaster County Beginning at a marked hickory a Corner of Ephraim Little's Land thence South 75 deg West 58 per: to a Spanish Oak thence North 58 deg West 47 per: to a Black Oak thence North 14 deg West 130 per: to a hickory thence North 50 deg East 25 per to a Black Oak thence South 40 deg East 57 per: to a hickory thence South 30 deg East 40 per: to a post^{by the creek} thence South 35 deg East 89 per & a half to the place of Beginning Containing fifty five acres & a half with the Allowance of Six Acres p cent for Roads &c Surveyed April the 14th 1739.
