Surveyed to John Hoyle on the 17th November 1823 the above described tract of two Runder and thirty five and nine tenths of an acre and allowance as represented by the Darch Lines Being part of two larger surveys that marked A.D. was surveyed to Andrew Ho Clain on the 8th day of December 1785 and contains one Runder and twenty eight acres and seven tenths of an acre and allowance by warrant of the 3rd March 1785 and that marked C.D. was surveyed to Thomas Patterson and Henry Dalton on the 11th March 1786 and contains three Runder and forty three acres and one quarter of an acre and allowance by warrant of the 9th January 1786 joining Thomas Ho Clanchan John King Samuel Hoyle and others in Center township Indiana County as appears from papers in my office
