



The above is the draught of a survey made May 15th 1785 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Christian Sellers on the 21st day of February 1785. It is situated on the South fork of Sen mile Creek in Washington County - contains 506 acres and 89 Perches with the usual allowance of 6 p^{er} Cent &c. & is called Delay.
