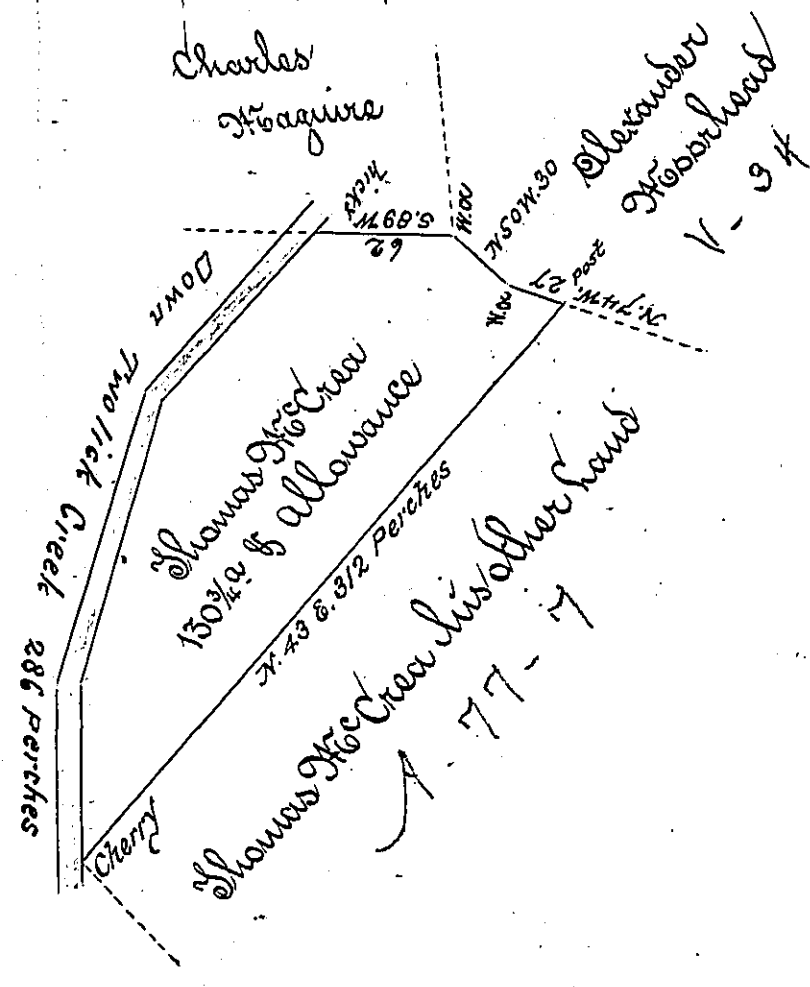

By warrant of the 26th day of August 1785.
