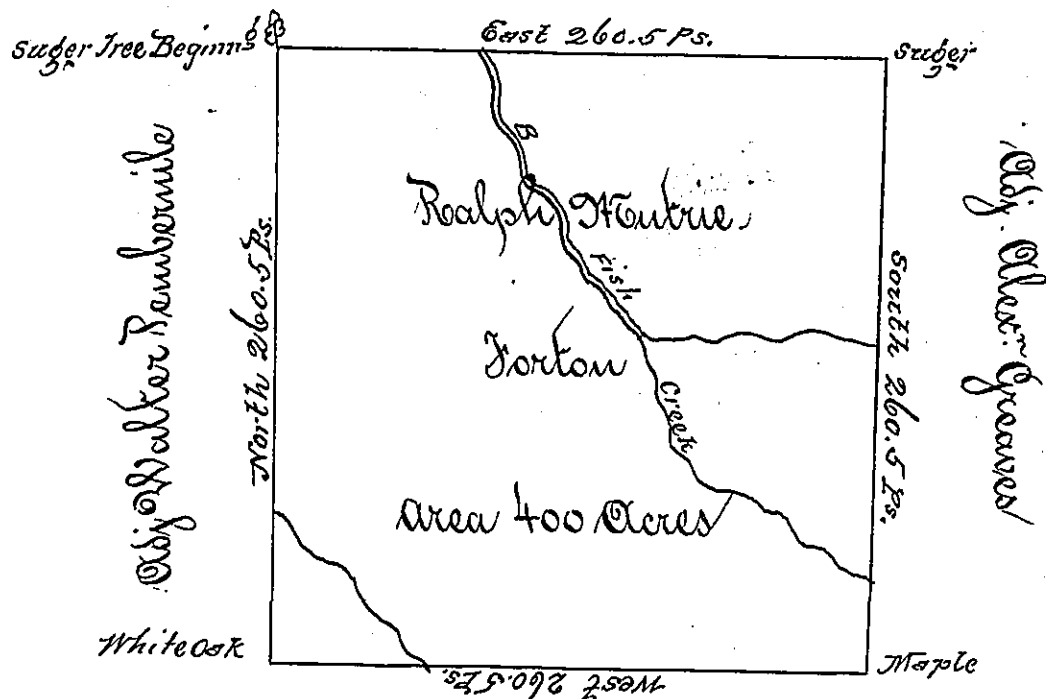


Adj Oliver Hoskins



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of Feb<sup>r</sup> 1785 in pursuance of a warrant Granted to Ralph Hentrie Dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of Oct<sup>r</sup> 1784 Situate on a Branch of Fish Creek Called Dorton in Washington County Containing four hundred Acres with usual Alloway of 6<sup>pr</sup> Cent for Roads
