



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 1793 and order of Survey rec<sup>d</sup> the 17<sup>th</sup> of May 1847 surveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of June 1847 to John Abbett the above described tract of land situate in Schuyl<sup>er</sup> Township formerly Northampton now Pike County near land formerly granted to Charles Boyd now William Overfield containing two hundred and twenty eight acres eighty nine perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
