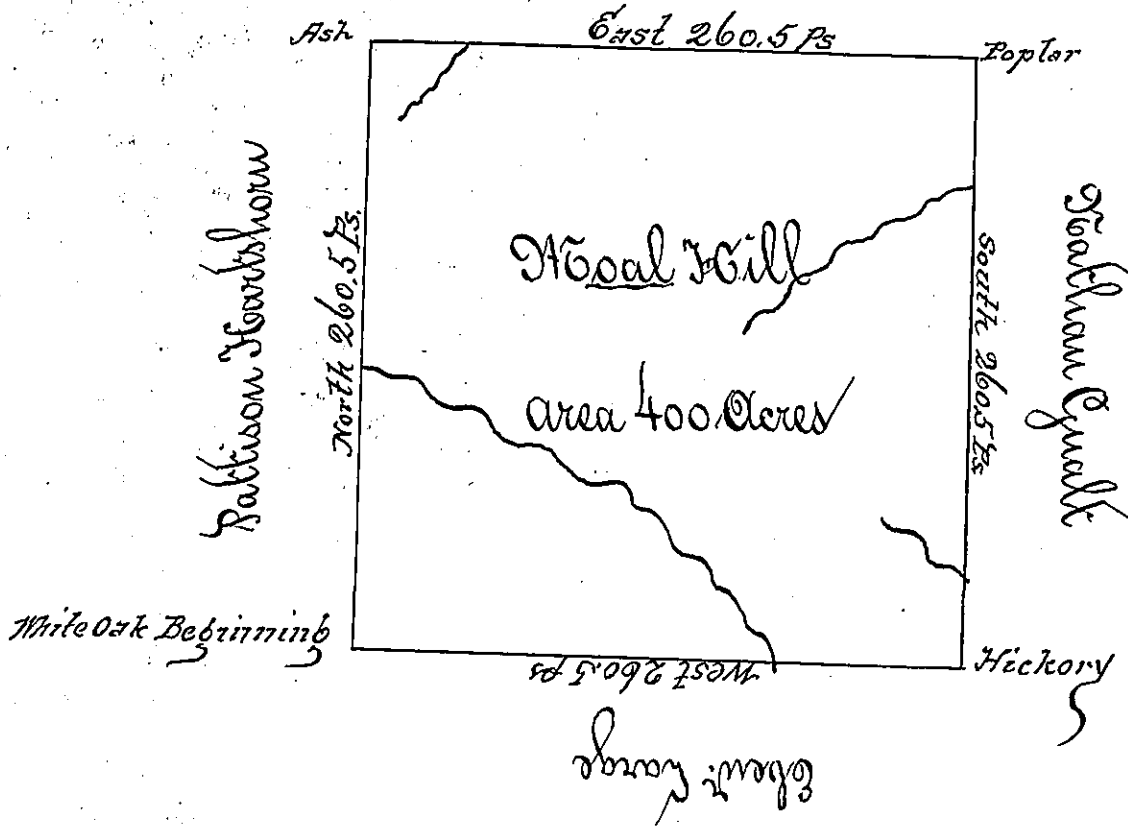


Thomas Franklin
