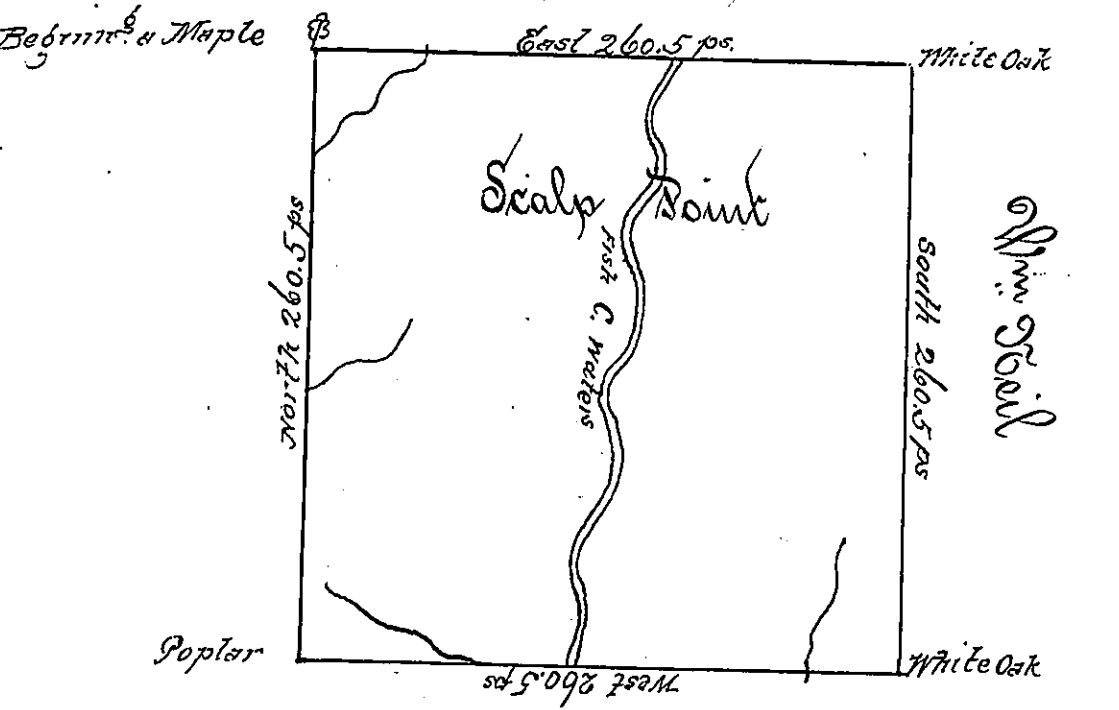


Hough Russell



The above is a draught of a survey made Jan<sup>ry</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Job Prince dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 1784 situated on the waters of Wheeling Creek adjoining lands of William Teiel in Washington County called Scalp Point containing four hundred acres with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads
