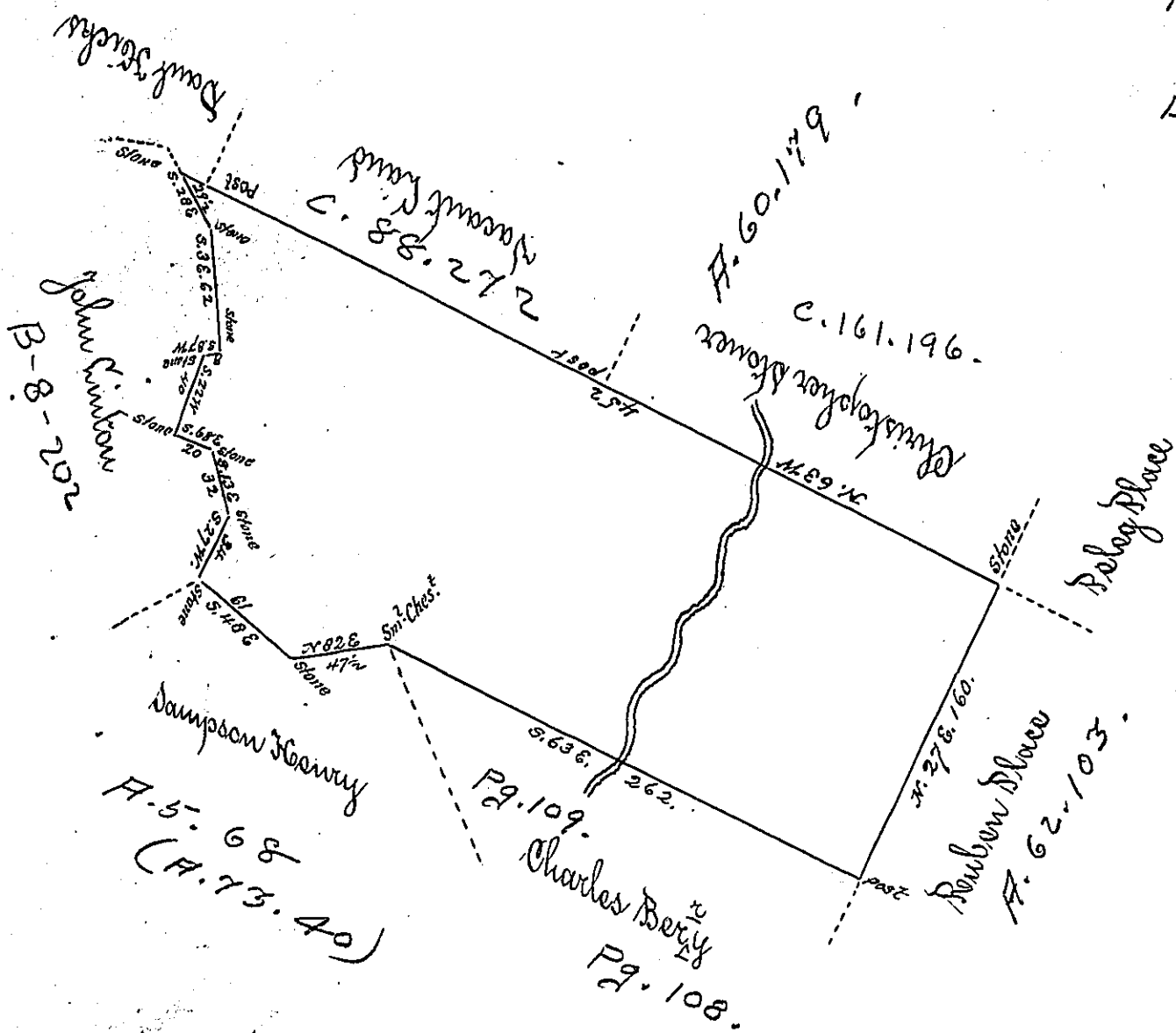

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 29th day of January 1795 surveyed the 26th day of November 1845 to Daniel Snyder the above described tract of land situate in Sackawaxen and Delaware Townships (formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining land granted to Charles Barry containing three hundred and eighty five acres one hundred and fifty five perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
