



Agreeably to your Order of the 14th Instth pursuant to a Warrant (to agree) Granted Balthazer Steinfeld dated 15th March 1765, I hereby Certify to have Surveyed the said lot, situate at the South East corner of Second Street from Delaware and Dock Street now in the possession of William Delany, Assignee of said Balthazer Steinfeld and find a lot of ground Thirty feet front on the East side of said Second Street to a stake Thence along the South West side of Dock Street Forty two feet six inches to the ground late of Henry Kisle, now of David Brientnal, Thence along the said ground Westward Thirty feet to S^d Second Street, as shown by the subjoined delineation
