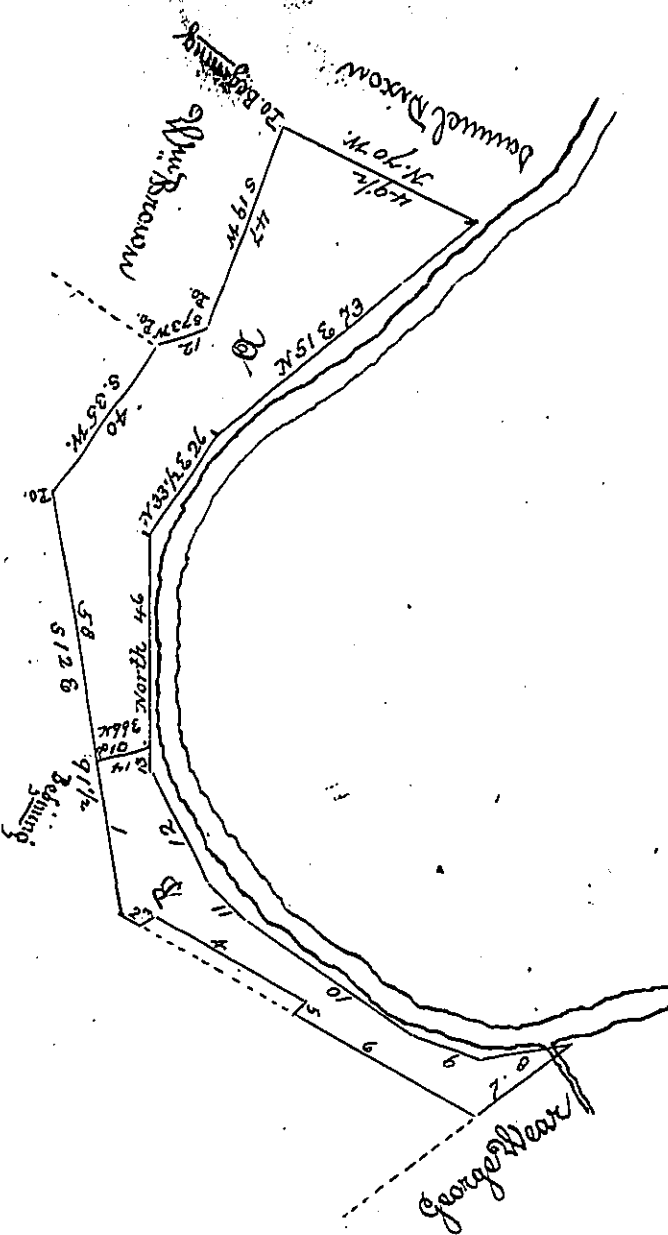

Surveyed to Charles Campbell the above described tract marked Letter A containing twenty acres and thirty perches and allowance of six per cent bounded on the east by Blacklick Creek adjoining lands surveyed to Daniel Dixon William Brown and others situate in Blacklick township Indiana County. By Warrant of the 25 November AD 1836

March 22<sup>d</sup> AD 1837

Surveyed to Charles Campbell the above described tract marked Letter B containing ten acres and one hundred and eight perches and allowance of six per cent bounded on the east by Blacklick Creek, adjoining lands surveyed to Andrew Cowers George Wear and land surveyed the same day to said Campbell. Situate in Blacklick township Indiana County. By Warrant of the 9<sup>th</sup> January AD 1837
