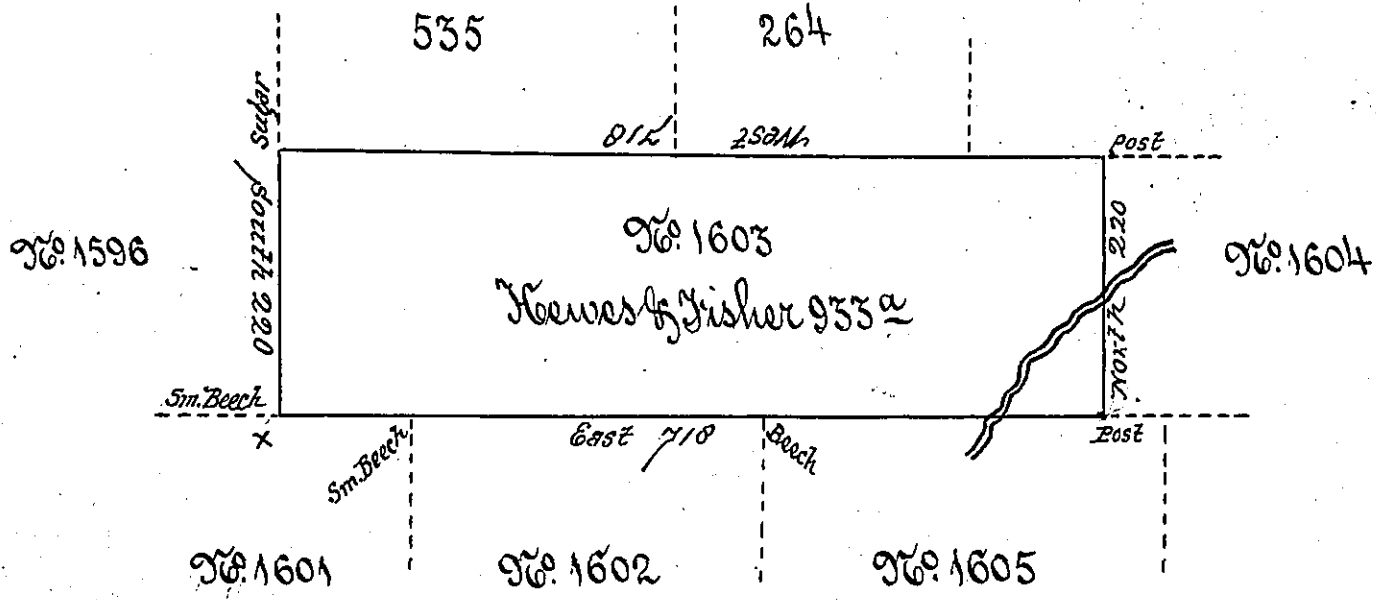


Joseph Carson
